CHECK THE PRINT FOR CERTIFICATION
MARKS FROM RECOGNIZED AUTHORITIES
LIKE CSA, UL, OR NSF.

WHEN BUYING FROM A NEW SOURCE, VERIFY
PRODUCT CERTIFICATION WITH CERTIFYING
AUTHORITIES LIKE CSA, UL, NSF.

REPORT ANY UNSAFE PRODUCTS TO THE LOCAL
OR PROVINCIAL AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION
(AHJ) SUCH AS THE ESA IN ONTARIO.
